The Muddy Footprints Challenge uses environmental stewardship to nurture environmentalists. The scheme has a wide appeal to all ages and close links to the national curriculum, making it an attractive concept for schools to take part in.

There are four stages to the challenge. Activities for each part of the award are grouped around the themes of Discover, Learn and Inspire. Participants who take up the challenge can track their progress on a pictorial trail. As you progress along the trail you will gain muddy footprint stickers. You will also receive a certificate at the end of each stage. A muddy footprints badge will be awarded to individuals who complete the four stages of the challenge, completed over several months.

The scheme is flexible so that individual challenges can be tailored to different age groups, and can incorporate the interests of individual participants. The challenge can be taken up by individuals, groups, school classes or families.
